ABOUT MANOS DEL URUGUAY

Manos del Uruguay was born in 1968 out of a simple question: How can we improve the quality of life of Uruguay's rural women? The answer was in handcrafts, using skills inherited from mothers and grandmothers and the raw material that was at hand: wool. The purpose of these jobs was not just an income for the women, but also opportunities for personal development and greater independence, while keeping their roots and traditions within their communities and with their families.

With the early success of the organization came expansion, the foundation of workshops all around the country. Social workers and the five original founders committed to give the women the necessary tools to organize production, administer the cooperatives, deal with suppliers and customers, and learn the difficult task of balancing work and family.





ALL OF MANOS' YARNS ARE HAND DYFD

The artisans use big kettles heated by wood fires, creating small batches of wonderful colors. The yarns' colors are bright and wild, full of nuances and variations. The same color recipe can look completely different, depending on the location in which it was dyed. This is because the dyeing process is very complex and is influenced by humidity, water quality, temperature etc. No two skeins are the same: each one is unique, a testimony of a particular moment.

Every skein has a tag with the artisan's signature and the name of the village where the cooperative is located. This helps remind the knitter that behind each skein there is a woman, a story.

Manos del Uruguay is a certified member of the World Fair Trade Organization.



ABOUT THE YARN

MARINA

Marina (100% merino wool superwash, 800m/100g) Is a single ply, incredibly light and soft laceweight yarn. Once you touch it, you don't want to let go again. Perfect for lace accessories knitting.



FINO

Fino (70% extrafine merino wool, 30% mulberry silk, 490m/100g) Is an elegant and refined yarn, which combines the softness of merino wool with the lustre of silk in a lightweight yarn that's perfect for heirloom accessories or luxurious garments. Fino features a new dye process that yields complex, subtle, tonal colors.




